Austria has the Vienna Philharmonic, Germany has the Berlin Philharmonic, Italy has the orchestra of la Scala of Milano, Greece has none.

The **National Symphony Orchestra of Greece** will change that. Bringing together the finest elite Greek musicians from around the world, we are building a modern, agile, asset-light orchestra with Athens as its home. Programs inspired by Greek themes and composers will be performed in Athens and tour the world's leading festivals and concert halls.

More than an orchestra, this will become a **global cultural brand**. To be associated with it will mean standing for heritage, excellence, and modern Greek prestige.

The orchestra is structured as a **non-profit association** designed to become self-sustaining through performances, tours, recordings, and digital distribution. All surpluses will be reinvested into the orchestra to secure long-term excellence and impact.

But first, it needs **visionaries** who will make history by bringing Greece the representative orchestra it deserves. This is a once-in-a-generation, time-limited opportunity to join at the very beginning and be forever recognized as part of its foundation.

THE PRODUCT

A non-profit association that will become **Greece's cultural flagship.** Lean and asset-light structure: a curated pool of elite Greek musicians from all over the world, joined by international artists when needed.
